

AWARD CONDITIONS

Introduction

1. There will be a number of ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences Undergraduate Scholarships for regional students. The number will be determined annually by the Dean of the College.

Value

2. The value of each scholarship will be determined annually by the Dean of the College but shall be no less than \$1000.

Eligibility

3. Eligible applicants shall:
 - Have applied to enrol in the first year of a degree program offered by the College of Arts and Social Sciences, either as a single or combined degree with another College on a full-time basis.
 - Be new to tertiary education.
 - Be a school leaver, or have completed school last year and are not already enrolled in any tertiary degree or diploma course this year.
 - Have been schooled in, and have their permanent home in, a regional area.*
 - Have made a significant contribution to their community; and
 - Be Australian citizens or hold Permanent Resident Status in Australia.

Tenure

4. The scholarships shall be tenable for a maximum of two consecutive academic semesters.

Application

5. Applications shall be called for with a closing date. Applications shall be submitted to the Dean of the College of Arts and Social Sciences.
6. Supporting statements must be provided by a school Principal and, where possible, a community representative. Applicants are also required to provide a personal supporting statement.

Selection

7. In any year the Selection Committee shall make the final determination on whether an application is eligible for consideration.
8. The selection for the scholarships shall be based on a combination of academic merit and contribution to the community.
9. The scholarships are for individuals only and shall not be shared.
10. The scholarships shall be awarded on the recommendation of a Selection Committee.
11. Scholarships will not be awarded when, in the opinion of the Selection Committee, there is no applicant of sufficient merit.

Concurrent holding of scholarships

12. Approval will not be given to hold the scholarships concurrently with any other scholarship.

Enrolment

13. Scholarships are not portable and will cease to be held if awardees change to a degree program outside the College of Arts and Social Sciences.

Commencement

14. Successful applicants will commence in the first semester of the academic year.

Payment

15. The scholarship shall be paid in two equal instalments at the beginning of semester one and semester two, upon confirmation of enrolment.

Termination

16. If a scholarship holder chooses to withdraw from a program or if their performance during the first semester is cause for concern, the Committee may review the scholarship and, after discussion and counselling with the student, may determine that the scholarship shall be terminated.

17. The scholarship may be terminated if the applicant fails to enrol in an Arts program or withdraws from the program before completing the year.

Publicity

18. Applicants agree that their photograph and particulars may be used, if necessary, for publicity by the College of Arts and Social Sciences.
